

Growing Catholic Education ("GCE") believes middle-income is relative to each family and based on unique circumstances. A MINIMUM and MAXIMUM income limit will be established relative to each family. Your 2019 Federal Tax Return will be required to complete this worksheet.

## WORKSHEET INSTRUCTIONS

SECTION 1
Minimum Income is determined by the total number of dependents in your household. Page 1 of your 2019 Federal Tax Return will be required for this section.

SECTION 2
Household Income is the total income from all sources for your household. Page 2 of your 2019 Federal Tax Return will be required for this section.

## SECTION 3

Maximum Income is the maximum allowed for a family like you. 2020-21 grade levels for your students and Dependent information will be required for this section.

## SECTION 4

Final Summary Using the final lines from Sections 1 through 3, a summary showing status if you qualify. You will still need to complete FACTS once approved by GCE.
